Use of cookies

What are cookies?

Cookies are small files saved and stored to the user's computer's hard drive that track, save and store information about the user's interactions and usage of the website. This allows the website, through its server to provide the users with a tailored experience within this website.

What do we use cookies for?

Wix.com uses several persistent cookies for purposes of session and user authentication, security, keeping the User's preferences (e.g., regarding default language and settings), connection stability (e.g., for uploading media, using e-Commerce features, etc.), monitoring performance of their services and marketing campaigns, and generally providing and improving their Services.

Google Analytics & Formilla

When someone visits www.mj-consulting.co.uk we use a third party service, Google Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way which does not identify an individual. We do not make, and do not allow Google to make, any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website.

Additionally, we use a Live Chat application on our website called Formilla. When someone visits our website, Formilla detects the IP address of that person, their geolocation (based on IP address look-up), and what device they're using when accessing our website. By default, Formilla only stores this information when you initiate a chat conversation or submit an offline email form when you're offline to assist in identifying the individual later. In the event the visitor submits an offline email form, their email address is retained as well. Additional data can also be collected from data subjects when using "pre-chat" form fields, including First Name, Last Name, Email Address, and other custom fields as you have configured in the "Advanced Options" of your Formilla chat settings. Customer data is retained indefinitely and remains available inside your Formilla account unless deleted from the Contacts page. Deleted data is removed from your Formilla account and can no longer be accessed online. The data is retained in an offline (inactive) state on Formilla servers. All customer data is backed up on a regular basis and stored on separate backup media for up to an additional 90 days, after which it is overwritten and/or deleted permanently. – **Further to Formilla's data storage policy; Matthew James Consulting will delete any data stored on Formilla after 3 months.**

Mailing Lists

As part of the registration process for our e-newsletter, we collect personal information which is stored by Wix. We use that information for a couple of reasons: to tell you about stuff you've asked us to tell you about; to contact you if we need to obtain or provide additional information; to check our records are right and to check every now and then that you're happy and satisfied. We don't rent or trade email lists with other organisations and businesses.
